Beginning the week of September 29, the Metropolitan District (MDC) and Genovesi Construction Company will begin replacing water mains and services on Revere Drive.

Work will start at the **Park Avenue (Route 178) intersection and continue north to the cul-de-sac over 5–6 weeks.** Construction will take place Monday–Friday, 7:00 AM–5:00 PM, with temporary traffic patterns in effect. Please watch for posted signs and updates as the project progresses.

FUN ACTIVITIES AT THE NEWLY-RENOVATED "OLD FARM SCHOOL SUNDAYS 1–4 pm

The Old Farm School has a fresh look — with a repaired roof, brand-new windows, and gutters. Come and ring the belfry bell of a schoolhouse built in 1796 when George Washington was president! Kids can sit at the desks of the past and play with replicas of 19th-century toys, such as hoops and balls, and a ball and cup, or practice writing with chalk and slate. The school's interior has been spruced up, too. Also, be sure to take in the exhibit honoring the 75th Anniversary of Wintonbury Historical Society – covering the decades from its founding in 1949 to today. It is displayed in the Gabriel History Center, located right behind the school. Stimulate the imaginations of the young ones and learn more about your town's history. Plan to visit soon!



The Old Farm School and the Gabriel History Center are open every **Sunday from 1 pm - 4 pm now through October 12.** The buildings, part of the Wintonbury Historical Society, are located at **151-153 School Street, on the corner of School Street and Park Avenue, Bloomfield.** Visits are free and open to

The Bloomfield Greater Together Community Fund at the Hartford Foundation for Public Giving has opened a second round of grantmaking for 2025. Nonprofits and community groups with fiscal sponsors are invited to apply for grants ranging from \$500 to \$10,000.

All projects must directly benefit Bloomfield residents. Applications are due by October 1, 2025.

In the spring, the Fund awarded \$35,000 to 11 local organizations supporting cultural programs, health and wellness initiatives, conservation, and community events. This new round provides another opportunity for local organizations to make a meaningful impact.

CT Automatic Admission Program: Earn Good Grades, Get Into College

Governor Ned Lamont is reminding high school students about the Connecticut Automatic Admission Program (CAAP), which guarantees admission to 10 participating colleges and universities for seniors with at least a 3.0 weighted GPA or 2.75 unweighted GPA. The program streamlines the process with one simple application, no fees, no essays, and no recommendation letters required. Applications for the 2026–2027 academic year are open now through May 1, 2026.

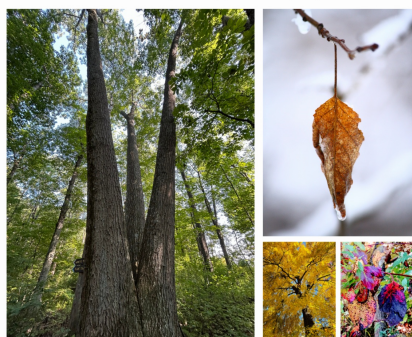
