

Bloomfield Charter Revision Commission Resolution

Be it Resolved, in accordance with Section 7-188 of the Connecticut General Statutes, and Section 1004 of the Bloomfield Town Charter, the Bloomfield Town Council does hereby, by an affirmative vote of at least two-thirds of its members, establish a Bloomfield Charter Revision Commission which will consist of five (5) members, all of whom shall be appointed by the Bloomfield Town Council at a duly noticed meeting of the Bloomfield Town Council within 30 days of the date of the adoption of this resolution.

Each of the members of the Bloomfield Charter Revision Commission shall be electors of the Town of Bloomfield; no more than one third of the members of the Bloomfield Charter Revision Commission may currently hold public office in the Town of Bloomfield; and no more than a bare majority of the members of the Bloomfield Charter Revision Commission may be currently enrolled as members of the same political party.

The Bloomfield Charter Revision Commission shall consider all recommendations received from the Bloomfield Town Council and the Bloomfield Charter Revision Commission shall submit its draft final report to the Bloomfield Town Council within 16 months of the date of the appointment of the members of the Bloomfield Charter Revision Commission.

The Bloomfield Charter Revision Commission may appoint officers from among its members, shall keep detailed records of its deliberations, and may adopt regulations and rules of procedure. The members of the Bloomfield Charter Revision Commission shall serve without compensation. The Bloomfield Town Council may remove any member of the Bloomfield Charter Revision Commission at any time in accordance with the procedures set forth in Section 703 of the Bloomfield Town Charter.

The Bloomfield Charter Revision Commission shall submit a progress report of its business at each regularly scheduled meeting of the Bloomfield Town Council.
