WHAT ARE THEY?

The **Deterra Drug Deactivation** and Disposal System is a simple, environmentally safe way to get rid of unused/unwanted/expired medications!

Why do we need safe medication disposal?

- Properly disposing of unneeded drugs helps prevent them from being misused or stolen.
- Keeping children, pets, and others safe from accidentally ingesting unused or expired drugs.
- Help keep unused medications out of our water and soil.

You can pick up a bag at **580 Cottage Grove Rd, Suite 100, Bloomfield, CT between 7:30 AM and 3 PM.**
No appointment is needed!
Proof of residency is required (ID, mail).
