



## TAX COLLECTOR'S OFFICE

The Town of Bloomfield, Connecticut will be conducting a tax sale of tax delinquent property on Wednesday, October 15, 2025.

The Town of Bloomfield hereby implements the following policy to prevent actual or perceived conflicts of interest in connection with the sale and in an effort to ensure that no bidder should have an unfair advantage over any other bidder. All bidders should have access to the same information about the property they might be bidding on.

Accordingly, bidder registration will be denied to Town of Bloomfield, Connecticut officials and employees who, by virtue of their position, could have access to information that would give those individuals knowledge not available to the general public. The Tax Collector has determined that registration and/or the right to bid shall not be allowed for the following Town of Bloomfield, Connecticut officials and immediate family members: *Town Council Members, Town Manager, Deputy Town Manager, Town Attorney, Director of Finance, Director of Building and Land Use, Town Clerk, Assessor, and Tax Collector.* Registration and/or the right to bid shall also not be allowed by all employees of the Town of Bloomfield and immediate family members, *Town Manager's Office, Department of Finance, Department of Building and Land Use, Town Clerk's Office, Assessor's Office, and Tax Collector's Office.* These departments/offices have involvement with the tax sale, and therefore, may be privy to certain information or documentation regarding the tax sale that is not widely available to the general public. In addition, all employees of the Town Attorney's law firm, Crumbie Law Group, LLC, are also not allowed to register and/or bid at the sale.

Under Connecticut General Statute §12-157, the statute that governs the tax sale, the Tax Collector has the sole discretion and authority to establish the rules of the tax sale. This rule restricting bidding by Town employees has also been approved by the Town Manager, the Director of Finance, and the Town Attorney.
